Plastics may be banned at Malpe beach

Udupi: Deputy Commissioner P. Hemalatha said on Sunday that the district administration was contemplating banning the use of plastic bags and other plastic items at Malpe beach and St. Mary's Island.

She was speaking after inaugurating a double-decker boat service to St. Mary's Island at Malpe port here.

Ms. Hemalatha said that the move would go a long way in keeping the environment both at Malpe beach and St. Mary's Island clean. The tourism sector had a lot of potential in the district, but facilities were developing at a slow pace. St. Mary's Island was a popular picnic spot, she said.
