CHENNAI: In a significant development, the Madras high court has directed the Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority (CMDA) to furnish a list of unauthorised constructions in the city and explain the action taken against the violators.

The first bench comprising <u>Chief Justice M Yusuf Eqbal</u> and Justice T S Sivagnanam gave the interim directive on a public interest writ petition filed by T Solomon of Choolai. As per a <u>CMDA</u>

in July this year, 5,000 building violations had taken place in the city over the past three years.
