## Chamber hails release of property tax data

MADURAI: The Tamil Nadu Chamber of Commerce and Industry has welcomed the release of data related to property tax on the Internet.

Chamber's senior president S. Rethinavelu welcomed the move to post door number-wise details of property tax for buildings along their street names in Madurai by the Corporation. In a press release, he said that this move would greatly increase transparency.

Pointing out to earlier complaints of buildings not being assessed for under-assessed for property tax, he said that this move provided an opportunity for the public to bring to the notice of the civic body the buildings that had escaped assessments.
